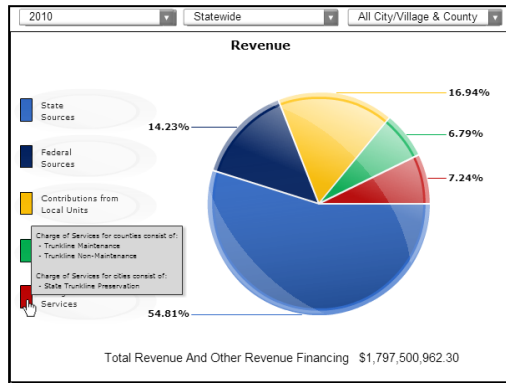


Finance Dashboard (Revenue)

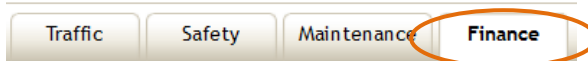


The Finance Dashboard is now updated with new Revenue Portion taken from Act 51 submittals.

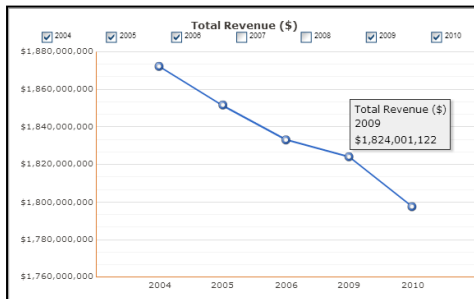


Hover over the legend to view how the category relates back to the Act 51 financial reports as these are different for counties and local agencies.

Finance Dashboard (Revenue Trends)



Another new portion of the Finance Dashboard is Revenue Trends. This takes the Revenue categories and allows the user to see changes over time in how funds were received in bar charts and line graphs.



Users can toggle off certain years to remove outliers for more accurate trends. This feature also gives the user the ability to focus on a specific time period of interest.

Annual Updates:

Dashboard Updates are made annually as new data becomes available to that specific program area.



Anyone can sign up for Gov Delivery on the Council Website to be notified when changes occur to the dashboards.

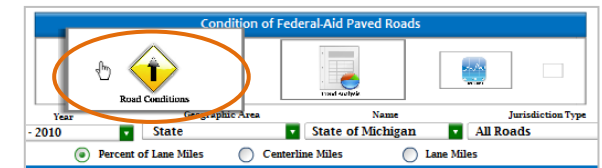

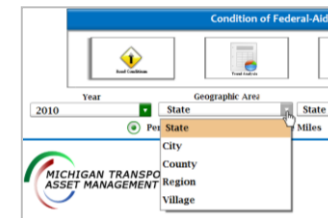
Data Access: Dashboards

Many dashboards have multiple sections. Mouse click the icon to reach your area of interest.



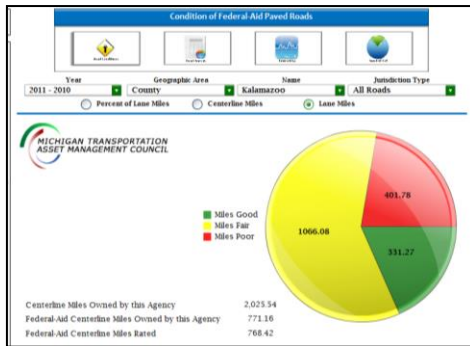
Each Chart has its own set of selection options that update the pie chart or other graphic being displayed.

The Pavement Dashboard shows Road Conditions, Trend Analysis and Forecasting based on PASER ratings of Good, Fair and Poor.

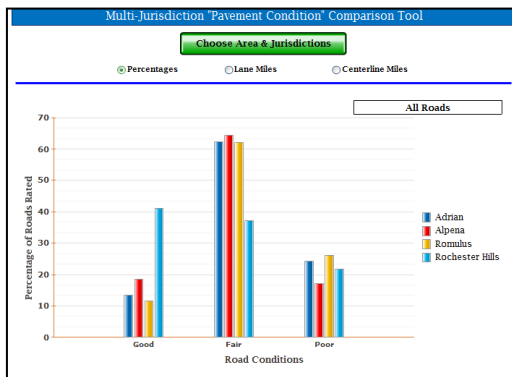


Annual PASER Ratings are collected in a collaborative effort by local, state, and multiple planning agencies.

The Pavement Comparison Dashboard provides a powerful tool to compare your agency with other areas or jurisdictions.

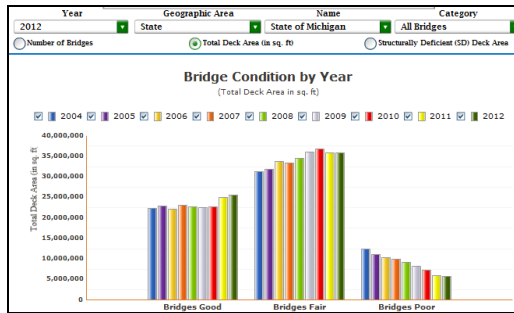


Up to 8 agencies can be viewed at the same time showing the amount of roads rated Good, Fair and Poor for each selection.

The Bridge Dashboard mirrors many features of the pavement dashboard with Good, Fair, Poor ratings.

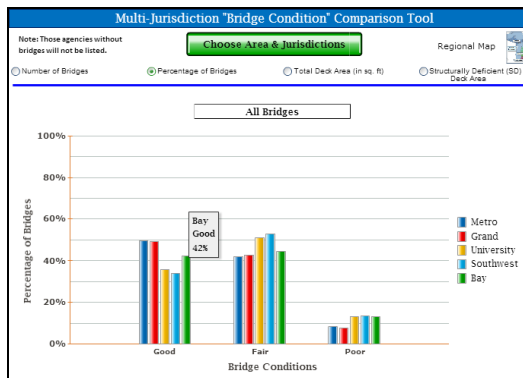


Bridge Conditions, Trends and Forecasting based on Total Deck Area and Structurally Deficient Deck Area are available.

Bridge Comparison Dashboard

Bridge **Bridge Comparison** Traffic

The Bridge Comparison Dashboard also provides the ability to make comparisons by viewing multiple agencies at the same time.

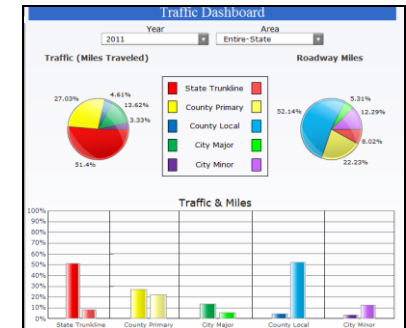


Metrics tied to Total Deck Area and Structurally Deficient Deck Area can be seen by year and specific area such as by region or at a local level.

Traffic Dashboard

Bridge Comparison **Traffic** Safety Maintenance

The Traffic Dashboard shows traffic volumes carried by public roads. from annual reports submitted to the Highway Performance Monitoring System (HPMS)



HPMS data is used by the Federal Government to analyze highway system condition and performance.

Safety Dashboard

Traffic **Safety** Maintenance Finance

The Safety Dashboard compiles Crash, Census and HPMS data to provide MAP 21 metrics such as Total Crashes/year on agency owned streets.



Numerous graph options show metrics by year and also provides a 3-year average to show trends and reduce the impact of an exceptional year.
